Extensive maintenance works on the technical facilities and infrastructure of Coque's Aquatic Center and Wellness Center

The Aquatic Center and the Wellness Center of the "Centre National Sportif et Culturel Coque" will remain closed this year from 16 July to 13 September inclusive. While the annual closure usually lasts around two weeks in August, additional technical and infrastructure-related works are required this summer. The measures commissioned by the "Administration des bâtiments publics" are intended to ensure the long-term preservation and modernization of the infrastructure.

The Coque wishes to inform its customers that the Aquatic Center, including the fitness area of the Aquatic Center, and the Wellness Center will remain closed for longer than usual this summer. As every year, maintenance, cleaning and repair works are carried out during the summer months. Due to the scope of this year's measures, however, an extended closure of both areas is necessary.

Works going beyond the usual annual closure

The works concern several technical and functional areas of the Aquatic Centre and the Wellness Centre and go well beyond the usual maintenance and cleaning operations. They include technical repairs, the renewal of installations, as well as works in various pool and operational areas.

These interventions are necessary to ensure that the facilities can continue to be used under the best possible conditions, both by the general public and for school and sports federation activities. A large part of these works concerns the technical infrastructure and is essential for the reliable operation of the facilities as well as for daily comfort, even though the results may not always be immediately visible to the public.

Complete renovation of the diving tower

As part of the works, the diving tower of the Aquatic Center will also undergo a complete renovation. Due to the scope of this specific measure, the diving area will remain closed for longer than the other areas of the Aquatic Center. The diving tower will therefore not be accessible until 13 October inclusive. All other areas of the Aquatic Centre and the Wellness Centre are expected to be accessible again from 14 September, after completion of the main works.

Subscriptions will be extended automatically

All subscriptions affected by the closure will be extended automatically. The additional closure days beyond the usual two-week annual closure will be taken into account. Customers will not need to take any further action. Coque thus ensures that subscribers will not be disadvantaged by the extended closure linked to the additional technical and maintenance works.

Coque is currently examining whether alternative swimming options can be offered on a limited basis during the closure period. The aim is to allow customers to continue their swimming sessions at least partially. Further information on this will be communicated at the beginning of July via Coque's channels.

The Coque would like to thank all its customers for their understanding and patience during these necessary works. These measures represent an important investment in the future of the facilities and help ensure that the Aquatic and Wellness Center can continue to be used safely, reliably and to a high standard.
